

## ***Special Brush Collection***

Because of the weekend storms the Township will offer a special brush collection service on Monday, August 1 and Tuesday, August 2. Residents do not need to contact the Township for this special collection service as the Public Service Department will be making a round of the whole Township.

Brush Collection Regulations:

- Limbs and brush should be placed along the curb, within four (4) feet of the edge of the street, ***but not in the street.***
  - ***Limbs larger than six (6) inches will not be picked up.***
  - Limbs that are four (4) inches or less in diameter may not exceed eight (8) feet in length.
  - Limbs more than four (4) inches but less than six (6) inches in diameter may not exceed four (4) feet in length.
- Hedges, vines, shrubs and other brush must be separated from tree limbs and securely tied in bundles less than sixteen (16) inches in diameter.
- Each property is limited to one (1) truckload of brush. This equals about six cubic yards.

A notice will be left at homes where the brush is not properly prepared for pick-up. The notice will explain why the brush was refused for collection.

Waste Management also offers a Yard Waste collection service. The next Waste Management Yard Waste collection will be on Wednesday, August, 17. Residents **must register** no later than 4:00 pm on Friday, August 5 for this collection.

Waste Management Yard Waste collection includes:

- Yard waste includes leaves in biodegradable bags
- Garden residue
- Shrubbery trimmings
- Limbs, twigs, brush, tree trimmings and similar material
- All tree trimmings and limbs must be cut in lengths less than four (4) feet and limbs must be less than three (3) inches in diameter. All material must be securely bundled and each bundle must weigh less than 40 lbs.
- ***NO*** grass clippings
