

**PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION

I. CALL TO ORDER

B. Park Courts

The Meadow Park Tennis Courts have significantly deteriorated. Due to the demand for pickle ball courts, the following options have been suggested:

Keep the two (2) tennis courts and paint Pickle Ball Lines on the Courts
Keep one (1) tennis court and create two (2) Pickle Ball Courts with nets
Change both tennis courts to Pickle Ball Courts with nets

After further discussion the consensus of the Parks and Recreation Commission was to send a survey to the area residents.
