AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF O'HARA AMENDING THE ZONING
ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL LOCATIONS FOR FIRE AND
EMERGENCY MEDICAL EQUIPMENT FACILITIES AND CHANGING THE
SIGNAGE LIMITATIONS FOR BUS SHELTERS

WHEREAS, the Township has undertaken a review of its existing zoning ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that certain changes should be incorporated into said ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Township of O'Hara hereby ordains that the Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 72-7.39 Conditional Uses CD-1

Add additional item "G" as follows:

G. Fire and Emergency Medical Equipment Facilities


SECTION 72-13.112.1.C(5) Bus Shelters

Change item "5" to read as follows:

- 5. Ancillary advertising may be included as part of the shelter, provided the total signage does not exceed twenty-four (24) square feet per face. Each shelter is limited to a single double-faced advertising panel on one side. The panel, if "V" shaped, must not have an angle greater than thirty degrees (30°). Bus shelters located within a residential, conservation or overlay zoning districts are not permitted to include ancillary advertising.
